We are looking to interview exceptional candidates who are committed to ongoing personal and professional growth and who are interested in a position as a full-time Fire Pit Manager. The Fire Pit Cultural Drop-In Centre is a street level, HIV/AIDS/HCV prevention and Harm Reduction program, founded in the philosophy of culture and healing as prevention. We seek a dynamic individual who can compassionately, comfortably, and confidentially work in an environment that respects diversity and has the ability to deal non-judgmentally with issues of addictions, poverty, homelessness, and the legacy of the colonization of Indigenous people.

- Degree or diploma in a field of study relevant to community and program development or equivalent combination of related education and work experience
- Exceptional knowledge related to HIV/AIDS and HCV, understands the complexities of working with diverse populations and has a thorough appreciation and awareness of Indigenous history and culture

- Ability to work from a risk/harm reduction perspective
- Experience with staff supervision and working at a managerial level
- Be self-motivated with excellent communication (written & verbal), organizational & time management skills
